He currently maintains a full-time position in a private practice limited to periodontal surgery and dental implant rehabilitation.

Dr. Moussa has lectured nationally and internationally on topics that include hard and soft tissue augmentation around implants, periodontal-plastic surgery, and partial extraction therapy (PET).
